President's Report

a wonderful Thanksgiving! Please note, we must have our articles into the Chatter by the

10th of each month. I know this is "repeat," and out of date, so I hope you are reading your emails (from constant contact), the information blog, and coming to coffee hour to get the latest news! **As of November 10, 2023**

The big question from all is, we signed the PSA, when do we get our money? As explained repeatedly, you getting your money is the very last thing in the order of this acquisition. So let me tell you what is happening now:

Rumors and questions being asked:

Pavers: After a visit to Country Lakes by our Activity Board, they came back with some information about pavers that is being experienced in Country Lakes. They were told that if you do not get pavers and you want to sell your house later down the line, you must put pavers in at that time. This is **NOT TRUE** for our park. We discussed this with MHM, and they indicated that if you sold your home and the purchaser wanted the pavers they could do so at the purchaser's expense. They also said that when a new home is brought in, pavers would be automatically laid, unless the purchaser has otherwise indicated no.

Please remember when hearing these things, each park is different in their terms with MHM. Bob Miller has said more than once that he was impressed with how many of our residents have those beautiful paintings on their driveways, and he understands why some would not want the pavers. This decision is yours and yours alone folks.

<u>Taxes</u>: As I am sure you all are getting that little envelope from our good friend Ken Burton, Jr, better known as the Tax Collector, I have had some questions about do I pay these taxes. The answer is **Yes**. These taxes are for 2023 real estate, so these are your responsibility.

Driver's License: You may be getting a call from Jan Twait, MiMi Sackett, Verna Hansen, Belle (from the office), or myself that informs you we do not have a copy of your driver's license in your files for age verification that will be required to prove that the percentage needed of 55 and older is correct. Please do not rush to the office after this meeting asking if they need yours, we will be making calls on the ones we need. We are in the

process of going through every file checking and are finding there are quite a few. I want to thank Jan, MiMi and Verna for helping get this task completed. I really appreciate all of you! (Side note: I was informed that Laura (our new part-time office assistant might be calling, too.)

Maintenance Fee: As we are still an association, we need to proceed doing business as an association. Therefore, a budget has been prepared for the upcoming year which includes the new maintenance fee and reserve fee. Shareholders will be receiving a letter probably within the next 10 days, with the proposed budget that the Board will be voting to approve next month (December Board meeting), your new maintenance fee, your new reserve fee and the lawn service rates for next year. So, no you will not be paying the \$635 on January 1st, but rather after closing.

Annual Meeting: There will be no annual meeting in February of next year. The purpose of the annual meeting is basically to elect new board members. When voting, on the sale of the park, you voted on three items and C, the third of those items state:

C. Do you approve the continuation of the terms of the current Board of Directors through the closing of the sale of the Park, the termination of all proprietary leases, the distribution of Co-op assets to the members following the sale, and the termination and windup of the affairs of El Rancho Village, Inc.?

Number of Yes Votes: <u>473</u> Number of No Votes: <u>59</u>

Therefore, we will have a regularly scheduled Board meeting in February, if needed for updates and the like.

Summary of Meeting on November 2, 2023 with MHM, Attorney, Manager and Executive:

Due Diligence: According to Jonathan this should begin by the end of next week (November 10). He was assured by MHM that we had turned in all that was necessary to proceed. This means he will write a letter to Bob Miller informing him that we have submitted all requested of us, Bob will have two days to review, respond and advise then at that time our 60 days begins ticking. As noted, before, all 556 title searches did not need to be completed, before due diligence is started. (*Side note, the notice was sent by attorney yesterday, November 9 to Bob Miller of MHM, he has five days to sign or respond. So, we are very close to starting the 60-day countdown!*)

Title Commitment: According to Jonathan the title company has indicated mid-November for completion. At that time, shareholder packets will be put together with signature pages. Remember, each packet will be different reflecting your deductions from your portion of the payout (water/sewer, any liens, or mortgages to be deducted).

Amendment #1 to PSA: We should be receiving this in the next few weeks. This is the legal description of the park, some schedules and exhibits that were excluded from the PSA that are normally worked on and added as amendments.

Market Pricing Guide: We are hoping to have a market pricing guide with what MHM will be charging for those shareholders who want to sell their homes after the sale to tell potential buyers. We know this will help you in listing your home.

As you can tell our meetings are getting shorter, which hopefully means we are getting closer.

December Rule Reminder

#4. GUESTS:

- a) A resident's guest who is a family member/guest, may remain in a resident's home in their absence or with a resident for no more than thirty (30) days within a 12- month period.
 - i. Guests under the age of 21 must be accompanied by an adult 21 years of age or older.
 - ii. Any guest occupying a unit in the owner's absence must register at the office.
- b) The resident is responsible for acquainting their guests with Park Rules and Regulations.
- c) Drunken, intoxicated, or offensive behavior shall not be tolerated.
- d) Caregivers: a request for a caregiver must be accompanied by a letter from your healthcare provider.
- e) A Background Check will be required if the Caregiver must remain for over a thirty (30) day period.
